COMPULSORY ATTENDANCE AGES POLICY

All children are required by New York State law to attend school full time, in a public, private or parochial school, unless exempt from attendance in conjunction with current law or regulation, and approved by the State Education Department from the first day of session in September of the school year in which the minor becomes six years of age through the last day of the school year in which such minor becomes sixteen years of age, unless he/she has completed a four-year high school course of study. A minor who has completed a four-year high school course of study.

All minors residing within Oxford Academy and Central School District from 16 to 17 years of age who are not employed shall attend the School District upon full-time day instruction through the last day of the school year in which the student becomes 17 years of age.

The Board of Education, through the Superintendent as chief administrative officer, is responsible for enforcement of the Compulsory Education Law.
