INTERVIEW OF STUDENTS BY POLICE

Police authorities may not interview students in the school building or use school facilities in connection with the police department work, and students shall not be made available for the purpose of a police interview. Police authorities must take any matter up directly with the parents or students off school premises. A warrant should be reviewed by school district counsel prior to the release of a student or the interview of a student. If a crime is committed on school property, it is expected that school officials will notify the appropriate police authorities regarding the event and give full cooperation in any investigation. In such a case, interviews of students and school personnel may be conducted on school property regarding such an incident.
