### Elinor Robb Troicke Memorial Scholarship

#### **Required Submission Materials**

For full consideration, applicants must submit:

- Completed Application Form.
- Copy of high school transcript or other educational documentation, including date, indicating current GPA at time of application submission.
- Proof of enrollment in a two or four-year college the semester following high school graduation

Preference is given to students with a minimum 3.20 (or equivalent) cumulative GPA at the time of application. Students applying for the Elinor Robb Troicke Memorial Scholarship must:

- Be enrolling in a two or four-year college the semester following high school graduation.
- Have completed volunteer service with one or more Chenango County not-for-profit organizations. Preference is given to those who have volunteered at (an)

- organization(s) directly or indirectly historical in nature.
- Intend on having a major or minor in museum studies, history, studio art, library sciences, education, or a related field.

Each June, the Chenango County Historical Society awards the *Elinor* Robb Troicke Memorial Scholarship to a graduating high school senior from Chenango County. Named after long-time volunteer museum educator, Elinor Robb Troicke, the scholarship has been awarded every year since 2013. The scholarship is presented during the Chenango County Historical Society's "Path Through History" celebration in June. All application materials must be submitted to the Chenango **County Historical Society (45** Rexford Street, Norwich, NY) no later than 4 pm on May 1. Applications received after this deadline will not be considered.

### The Doctor Thomas F. Manley Nursing Scholarship/Loan Fund is

available to Chenango County students who are interested in pursuing a nursing career.

The scholarship consists of a minimum of \$500 up to \$2,000 to be paid(possibly in divided payments) to any accredited school of professional nursing in which the applicant is enrolled.

The applicant must be in the upper half of the class scholastically, have a need for financial assistance and a sincere interest in the profession of nursing.

The terms of the scholarship/Loan Fund are as follows:

- 1. If the applicant shall practice the profession of nursing for one year at Chenango Memorial Hospital, Inc, Norwich, New York, upon graduation and licensure by the State of New York, the loan shall be canceled as though paid in full.
- 2. If the applicant fails to complete the nursing program or is not accepted for employment at CMH,INc as provided in paragraph 1, the loan will be repaid to the Doctor Thomas F. Manley Nursing Scholarship/Loan Fund. The loan shall be repaid within two years, interest free. If payment is not made within two years, interes at the prevailing interest rate at the time the repayment schedule is determined, compounded each six (6) months, shall be charged.

Students interested in filing an application with the Scholarship Committee must complete and submit the following by May 15th.

- Letter of Application stating reasons for pursuing a professional nursing career.
- 2. Three (3) letters of reference, from teachers, employers, clergy, etc, who can give the Committee insight into the applicant's character and ability to complete a nursing program.
- 3. A copy of the high school/college transcript.
- 4. An interview scheduled by the applicant with Ms. Rachel Dubach at UHS Chenango Memorial Hospital, Inc. (Tel #607-337-4294.

## Afton Central School Pool Orientation and Pre requisite swim 6:30 pm on February 13, 2023

To register or for questions about the course call Lila Harris at 607-624-5824 or Sue Shove at 607-821-8137. Cost of the course is \$225 and includes certification, COR mask and lifeguard pack with whistle. Review is \$150 and does not include mask/fanny pack/whistle.

Prerequisite swim is a 300 yard swim using breaststroke, crawl stroke and rhythmic breathing, 2 minute treading water with legs only and a timed swim to retrieve a 10 pound weight. \*\* Persons wishing open water certification need 550 swim, all listed above and an additional object retrieval/underwater.

This is a blended learning course requiring 19-24 skill hours in addition to 8+ hours on the computer.

Class times will be 6 - 9 pm February 15, 16, 23, 27 and March 1, 2, 6, 8, 9. We will hand out course requirements and other information at the first class meeting.

There is open swim from 6:30 - 7:30 pm at the pool on Tuesday and Thursday evenings. You should get some conditioning in if possible before the course begins.
