SFCU Scholarship Program

(Membership Eligibility Required)

James Suriano & Wayne King Community Service Scholarship

This scholarship is named In Memory of James Suriano and Wayne King, who served on the SFCU Board of Directors, and held the position of Chairman, respectively. This scholarship is awarded to the applicant who has exemplified Jim and Wayne's commitment to community involvement. Both gentlemen participated in numerous activities, volunteering their time, and serving others. The recipient of this scholarship will also possess these attributes.

SFCU will award one scholarship recipient each year to receive \$5,000 annually over their 2–4-year college career. The scholarship will be paid jointly to the student and educational institution. The funds may be used towards tuition, room and board,

books, school supplies, meal plans and/or other education related expenses.

The application and essay response must be submitted electronically by March 15, 2025. If any portion is incomplete or missing, the application will not be considered.

The Hagan Scholarship

Basic Eligibility Requirements:

1. Must graduate from a public, private, charter, magnet, or STEM high school
2. Must have achieved a 3.5 GPA
3. Must enroll in an eligible 4 year college or university the first semester following graduation
4. Must maintain a 4 year or less graduation schedule
5. Must work 240 hours prior to commencement of the fall semester in college
6. Applicants Adjusted Gross Household Income reported for 2023 Federal Income Tax Purposes must not have exceeded \$100,000

The American Legion Riders Post 259 Veterans Scholarship

Available to graduates of a local high school whose parent(s) enlisted in the armed forces on or after September 11, 2001 and are either active duty, a veteran, or an active first responder.

The eligibility requirements for consideration of an American Legion Riders Post 259 Riders Post Veterans Scholarship are as follows:

1. An applicant must be a legal child of a post-September 11, 2001, active duty service member, veteran, or active first responder..
2. An applicant must reside in Otsego, Delaware, or Chenango County.
3. An applicant must be a high school senior or high school graduate to apply for the scholarship.
4. An applicant must be considered of good moral character.

Elinor Robb Troicke Memorial Scholarship

Each June, the Chenango County Historical Society awards the Elinor Robb Troicke Memorial Scholarship to a graduating high school senior from Chenango County. Named after long-time volunteer museum

educator and former Oxford Academy Art Teacher, Elinor Robb Troicke, the scholarship has been awarded every year since 2013. The scholarship is presented during the Chenango County Historical Society's "Path Through History" celebration in June. **All application materials must be submitted to the Chenango County Historical Society (45 Rexford Street, Norwich, NY) no later than 4 pm on May 1, 2025. Applications received after this deadline will not be considered.**

Preference is given to students with a minimum 3.20 (or equivalent) cumulative GPA at the time of application.

Students applying for the Elinor Robb Troicke Memorial Scholarship must:

- Be enrolling in a two or four-year college the semester following high school graduation.
- Have completed volunteer service with one or more Chenango County not-for-profit organizations. Preference is given to those who have volunteered at (an) organization(s) directly or indirectly historical in nature.
- Intend on having a major or minor in museum studies, history, studio art, library sciences, education, or a related field.

Required Submission Materials

For full consideration, applicants must submit:

- [Completed Application Form](#).
- Copy of high school transcript or other educational documentation, including date, indicating current GPA at the time of application submission.
- Proof of enrollment in a two or four-year college the semester following high school graduation (such as a copy of college acceptance letter, etc.).
- Proof of declared major or minor in museum studies, history, studio art, library sciences, education, or a related field (such as a copy of college application, etc.).

- Signed letter from volunteer supervisor with the organization(s) served, indicating a total number of hours volunteers and tasks accomplished.
- Signed recommendation letter from a high school guidance counselor or another school administrator.

AFA's Teen Alzheimer's Awareness Scholarship

AFA's Teen Alzheimer's Awareness Scholarship provides educational funding to college-bound high school seniors who have been impacted by Alzheimer's disease.

Applicants are asked to write an essay (1,500 word maximum) or submit a video (no more than 4 minutes long) describing the impact of Alzheimer's disease or other dementia-related illnesses on themselves or their family, what they have learned, and how they intend to advocate and bring awareness to Alzheimer's and dementia in the future.

The grand prize winners receive \$5,000, with additional prizes awarded for runners up. More than \$428,000 in college scholarships have been awarded since the program's inception.

- **Eligibility:** High school seniors, as well as college freshmen and sophomores, pursuing degrees in manufacturing, manufacturing engineering, or technical fields that support manufacturing.
- **Award:** For Associate Degree programs the award is \$2,500 per year up to 2-years (\$5,000 max)

QUALIFICATIONS FOR CONSIDERATION:

- An applicant must be a resident of, and a senior enrolled in a high school in Chenango County.
- The applicant must be planning to study music with the intent of pursuing a career in this field. Awarding of the scholarship is contingent upon the acceptance of the applicant into an appropriate department in an institute of higher learning.
- The applicant cannot be a member, or a relative of a member or associate member of the Monday Evening Musical Club.
- **Three** personal, written references from non-related individuals are required to be submitted at the time of application. One reference must be from a music instructor and another from a school guidance counselor. References must be mailed by the individuals directly to the Scholarship Chairperson listed below.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Applications may be obtained from any Chenango County High School Music Department, Guidance Department, or from certain private music teachers after they are distributed in February. **All applications should be returned to the Scholarship Chairperson listed below by April 1, 2025.**

Each applicant will be required to audition before the Scholarship Committee. This committee will determine the winner(s) and the announced decision will be final. It is not mandatory that the Committee award a scholarship after hearing the applicants in a given year. **Scholarship winners will be required to perform for the members of the Monday Evening Musical Club at its May meeting. (Performance not to exceed 6 minutes).**

The awarding of the Scholarship will be announced at each winner's high school Commencement exercise. **Upon the successful completion of the first semester, and subsequent enrollment in the second semester in a music program, the scholarship award will be paid to the University in the student's name.**
