Horatio Alger Association of Distinguished Americans, Inc.

Eligibility Criteria:

To be considered eligible for Horatio Alger National and State Scholarship programs applicants must:

- Be enrolled full-time as a high school junior in the United States, progressing normally toward graduation in spring/summer 2025 with plans to enter a college in the United States no later than the fall following graduation
- Exhibit a strong commitment to pursue and complete a bachelor's degree at an accredited non-profit public or private institution in the United States (students may start their studies at a two year institution and then transfer to a four-year institution).

- 3. 3. Demonstrate critical financial need (\$65,000 or lower adjusted gross family income is required)
- 4. Be involved in co-curricular and community service activities
- 5. 5. Display integrity and perseverance in overcoming adversity
- 6. Maintain a minimum grade point average (GPA) of 2.0
- 7. Be a United States citizen
