SENIOR REMINDERS:

For seniors who are planning to attend college: your final high school transcript will be sent to the college that you have indicated that you plan to attend (on the Post Graduation Plan form). If you did not complete the Post Graduation Plan form, your transcript will not be sent. If your plans change and you will be attending a different college, please let the Guidance Office know. **Your final transcript cannot be sent until the week after graduation.** Colleges are already requesting final transcripts, but until students graduate, the transcript can't be sent.

Seniors who are graduating that have taken dual credit courses such as College Level US History or College Composition/Literature may have earned college credits through Morrisville or TC3.

STUDENTS must contact the college to have their transcript sent to the college they will be attending in the fall. **The guidance office does not have access to students' college transcripts or ID numbers.** Students must request college transcripts, parents cannot.
