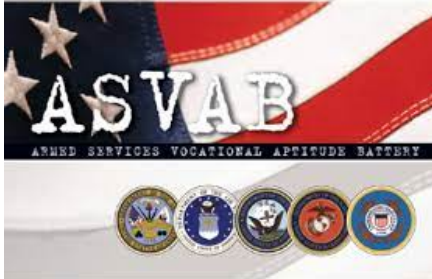

ASVAB

(Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery)

The ASVAB will be given at school on Friday, November 22, beginning promptly at 8:30 am. The test will be on the computer and will take approximately 1.5 hours to complete. Students will need to bring their charged Chromebooks to school with them on the day of the test. Students are responsible for making up any school work that they miss that day. In order for students to take this test they must have parental permission. Letters of explanation and permission slips were sent home and are due in the Guidance Office by Wednesday, November 13. Paper copies are available in the Guidance Office.

College Open House Information



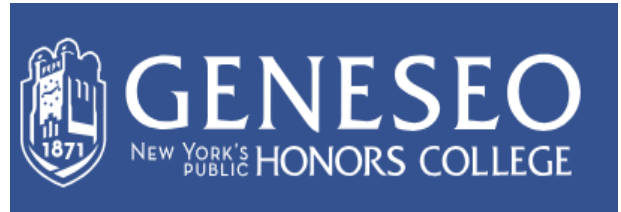
