	 All students will "enter the arena" on IXL diagnostic to keep up to date recommendations. All students will participate in writing benchmarks 3 times a year.
	 The progress of students in need of intervention services will continue to be monitored using appropriate assessments
	 All grades will set aside a designated time to incorporate daily Heggerty instruction Grades K through 3 will collaborate weekly to discuss HMH scope and sequence. Each grade level will be consistent with pacing and assessment administration within a week timeframe of each other
